# 26<sup>th</sup> Workshop, May 11 - 12, 2023 *The Synthesis and Applications of Isotopes and Isotopically Labelled Compounds*

### Invitation

On behalf of the International Isotope Society - Central European Division - we are pleased to invite you to the 26<sup>th</sup> 'Bad Soden' Workshop on May 11 –12, 2023, this time again in the **H4 Hotel at Frankfurt Messe** and not at our traditional location in Bad Soden. We had to change the venue on short notice due to technical reasons. The focus of the meeting is the synthesis and application of isotopes and isotopically labelled compounds in all research disciplines. Amongst the topics to be covered are: New methods in synthetic organic chemistry relevant to isotopic labelling, applications of radioactive and stable isotopically labelled compounds in research and biosciences, PET chemistry, new trends in analytics and measuring techniques, radioactive storage management and waste disposal. By established tradition an analytical pre-workshop starting on Thursday (May 11) morning will be organized by Dr. Martin Sandvoss.

### Conference Site

The workshop will be held at the H4 Hotel Frankfurt Messe located in Oeserstreet 180, D-65933 Frankfurt/Main, Germany. The hotel can easily be reached by train S1 or S2 leaving from Frankfurt central station to Frankfurt-Griesheim (5 min) or Frankfurt-Nied (8 min) or by car/taxi from Frankfurt airport.

From Frankfurt-Nied train station the walking distance to the hotel is ca. 20 min. In addition the bus no 59 could be taken. The bus stops close to the hotel.



### Call for Presentations

As in past years, the organising committee asks for your active participation in this event and invites all colleagues working in the field of isotopic labelling to present their research work in either oral or poster format.. Oral presentations from 10 to 30 min are possible. This workshop is also a good opportunity for young researchers from academia to present their current work; financial support can be provided on request.

**To help us in generating a preliminary outline for the scientific part of the workshop, please let us know of your interest in presenting your work (oral or poster format) as soon as possible. The deadline for applications (see abstract submission form) is April 11, 2023.**

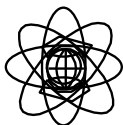

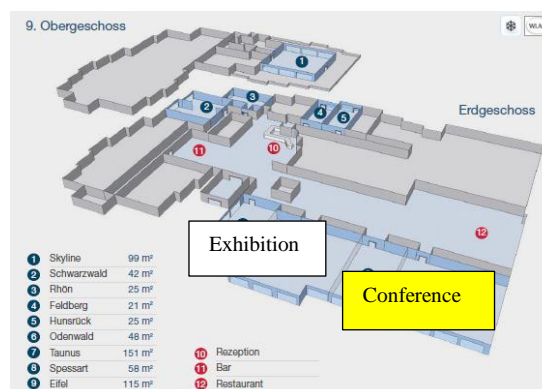


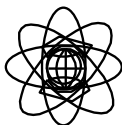
## Sponsoring

**By airplane:** From Frankfurt airport it is the best to go by taxi (distance 12 km) to the conference site (15-20 min, 30-35 Euro). Or you can go by Bus 58 (in direction to Frankfurt Main Höchst Bahnhof) – leave the bus at ‘Frankfurt Höchst Bahnhof’, then switch to bus 59 (in direction to Erzbergerstrasse) – leave at ‘Am Neufeld’ (roughly 1 h).

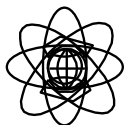
**By train:** From Frankfurt Main Station (Hbf): You can use the S-Bahn S1 or S2 in direction to Wiesbaden and leave at ‘Frankfurt-Nied’. From Frankfurt-Nied the conference site is within walking distance of ca. 20 min, following the Oeserstreet. Or you take the bus No. 59 (in direction to Erzbergerstrasse) coming every 20 min (leave bus stop “Am Neufeld”).

**Authors (First name, second name, presenting author underlined, Times New Roman Size 12, bold, center text)**

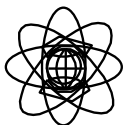

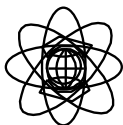
